Student volunteers are an important and integral part of ICALP! Student volunteers support the various programs and events hosted at the conference and will therefore serve in several support roles. The conference will be held at ITU in Copenhagen from Monday July 7th to Friday July 11th, 2014.

What is ICALP?

International Colloquium on Automata, Languages and Programming (ICALP) is the premier theoretical computer science conference held in Europe. Attendees include some of the best researchers and research students from around the world. The conference is a great opportunity to network with computer scientists from both academia and private companies.

What do student volunteers do?

As a volunteer, you agree to work around 20 hours across a variety of tasks:

- Making sure that presentations run smoothly.
- Manning the registration desk and taking care of various ad-hoc tasks.
- Supporting conference events such as the dinner and the canal tour.
- Assist conference attendees regarding any questions.

There will be a mandatory orientation session for student volunteers Sunday July 6th.

What do student volunteers get in return?

In return for their help at the conference, student volunteers will receive a number of benefits:

- Free conference registration.
- The opportunity to attend presentations by leading researchers.
- Conference dinner.
- After party for volunteers.
- Student volunteer T-shirt.

In addition to participating in the conference sessions, student volunteers get the opportunity to exchange ideas with students with similar interests from all over the world, and a chance to network with professionals in a relaxed environment during the conference's social events.

How do student volunteers apply?

Call for volunteers opens on Monday the 31st of March 2014 and closes on Wednesday the 30th of April 2014. After the call has closed 15-20 students will be selected as volunteers. All other students who are registered will be assigned a position on the waiting list.
